Downriver Mutual Aid Report:

DRANO Report: No report.

Police Report: Chief Dan Grant reported: 1) The SWAT Team had four call-outs (Southgate, Ecorse, Woodhaven, and Detroit Metro Airport for a peaceful protest/demonstration); 2) The Dive Team had 14 callouts for the 2016 year along with five training sessions and two public relations events to demonstrate various equipment.

Fire Report: Chief Jeff Drouillard reported. 1) No meeting held in December, 2) working on finishing up with getting the Accountability System operational; 3) End of year team reports will be given at the next meeting; 3) the Haz Mat Team had no call outs in the last couple of months; they held a four day officer class; and are continuing with training; attendance has improved over the last couple of months; 4) Fire Investigation Team had no activity, 5) The dive team had no activity; and they continue to do monthly training; 6) the Logistics Team had no call-outs and they continue to work on call-out procedures; and they continue with training and recruitment; 7) HEMS is looking at reviewing the minimum staffing requirements for a paramedic truck. 8) Question by board member about the new drug boxes, Chief Drouillard replied that the new boxes are smaller and cheaper. He added that Narcan levels are coming back in stock – no more shortages at this time.

The next regular board meeting is scheduled for Thursday, February 2nd at 6:00 p.m.
