<u>Agenda:</u> Motion by Mayor McLeod supported by Mayor Swift, to accept the agenda as presented. The motion passed unanimously.

Minutes of 2/1/2024: Motion by Mayor McLeod, supported by Mayor Rzeppa, to accept the minutes of the regular board meeting of 2/1/2024 as presented. The motion passed unanimously.

Executive-Finance Committee Report: Chair Glaab reported.

<u>Fiscal Policies</u>: Maria Mancos, Controller, reported. Maria presented the Fiscal Policies (included in the board packet) for review/approval, indicating that approval is required annually. She gave an overview of the policies that were updated/changed. Motion by Supervisor Budny, supported by Mayor Pro-Tem Lamb, the motion passed unanimously.

New Business:

Jazmine Danci listed the updates from Cal Kirchen of Congresswoman Dingell's office, as he was unable to attend the DCC board meeting.

➤ The three Downriver appropriations this year were for Gibraltar's water main infrastructure; SHUVA funds; and West Jefferson corridor project funds. Cal sent his congrats to the recipients and said they only hope to provide more resources for the Downriver region again. Their work continues.

Dingell's funded community project requests for fiscal year 2024 include the following:

- \$550,000 for the Downriver Community Conference to reconstruct the Jefferson Avenue corridor
- \$1,000,000 to replace the City of Gibraltar's watermain infrastructure
- \$1,800,000 for the reconstruction of Saline's wastewater treatment plant
- \$959,752 for improvements to the South Huron Valley Utility Authority (SHVUA) wastewater treatment plant

Cal Kirchen (Congresswoman Dingell's Office) update:

- \$360,000 to rehabilitate the City of Milan's senior center
- \$500,000 to rebuild the Chelsea Area Fire Authority Fire Facility
- \$500,000 for improvements to the Village of Manchester wastewater treatment plant
- \$963,000 for upgrades to Northville Township's emergency communications technology
- \$1,684,132 for Canton Township to construct a new fire station
- \$1,666,279 to complete common area infrastructure upgrades in Ypsilanti
- \$500,000 to improve pedestrian safety signals in Ann Arbor
- \$850,000 for Dexter Community School District to build a multi-generation community center
- \$500,000 for reconstruction and improvements to Belleville Road in Van Buren Township
- \$1,000,000 for the Washtenaw County Road Commission Hewitt Road
