Police Team Report Police Chair, Chief Jeff Watson reported

<u>DMA SWAT</u>: Had one callout on Nov 13th for a high-risk arrest/search warrant for an Allen Park case in the City of Detroit to arrest two suspects, both subjects and the weapon were taken into custody without incident.

<u>DMA/Crisis Negotiation Team</u>: Assisted with the above warrant for Allen Park and assisted Wyandotte PD on a barricaded subject on November 10th, where they peacefully resolved the situation

<u>CNT and SWAT</u> are planning on a Spring DMA scenario and are collaborating currently looking for locations.

<u>DMA Crash Team</u>: Responded to crashes in November in Lincoln Park, Wyandotte, and Trenton

<u>DMA Major Crimes Task Force</u>: Detectives from DMA agencies met on November 29th at Brownstown PD and Task Force Commander Starzec went over the Task Force Policy and Procedure. Discussion included the need for DMA training and equipment that would benefit the team and DMA as a whole.

<u>Dispatch Consolidation</u>: Discussions are currently underway between several DMA communities to attempt to implement the first phases as outlined in the Mission Critical Study
